Designed to recruit and retain community-based mental health professionals serving in rural and underserved areas in Illinois, the Community Behavioral Health Care Professional Loan Repayment Program provides student loan repayment assistance to qualified mental health and substance abuse professionals.

### To be eligible for the program, at minimum you must:

- Have an outstanding balance on an eligible educational loan
- Work as a licensed provider in one of the following behavioral health professions: psychiatrist, psychologist (PhD., Psy.D.), advanced practice nurse, physician assistant, clinical social worker, clinical professional counselor OR as a Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC).
