

## Determining 2020-21 Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP) Award Amounts

Illinois Monetary Award Program maximum eligibility is calculated based on a student budget, which is 2009-10 tuition and fees (no cap) plus a uniform living allowance of \$4,875 (for academic year 2020-21), minus an Illinois inflated EFC including a minimum student self-help expectation of \$1,800, minus 80 percent of 2009-10 Pell eligibility with a \$5,350 maximum.

For academic year 2020-21, MAP initial awards are limited to the lesser of the program effective maximum award of \$5,340, 100 percent of academic year 2009-10 tuition and fees, or maximum eligibility. A student must have a minimum initial eligibility of \$300 to be considered for an award. Initial awards for less than the program maximum award or tuition and fees are rounded in \$150 increments. No awards are provided to applicants with a federal EFC of \$9,000 or greater.

For academic year 2020-21, the statutory maximum award of \$6,468 is limited to an effective maximum of \$5,340 by formula and available appropriation. No reduction factor will be applied to final awards.
