## SECTION 5: GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

- Due to a shortage of school and municipal social workers in Illinois, an incentive program has been designed to encourage longevity and career change opportunities. The School and Municipal Social Work Shortage Loan Repayment Program is intended to assist in paying eligible loans to provide an incentive to school and municipal social workers to maintain their careers within Illinois.
- Assistance under this program may be received one time; the assistance cannot exceed the outstanding balance of the eligible educational loan(s) or \$6,500.00 whichever is less. Eligible educational loans include Stafford loans, Graduate PLUS loans, consolidation loans, Perkins student loans, Supplemental Loans for Students, alternative loans and other types of government and institutional loans used for education expenses.
- Proceeds will be remitted directly to the holder/servicer/lender of the loan(s) to be repaid.
- The total number of awards each year is contingent on available funding. If funding is insufficient to pay all eligible applicants, awarding will be based on the date the complete application, with all required documentation, is received in ISAC's Deerfield office and in the following order: first to new qualified minority applicants and then to other new, qualified applicants.
- The documentation required in Section 3 and any other requested documentation must be submitted as a part of this application.
- If the application is incomplete, ISAC will notify the applicant who will have an opportunity to furnish the missing information. The application will only be considered for processing as of the date the application is complete and received at ISAC's Deerfield office.

# **SECTION 6: DEFINITIONS AND ELIGIBILTY REQUIREMENTS**

DEFINITIONS

- Authorizing Official: the official who has access to employment records that establish your eligibility for loan forgiveness in accordance with the requirements explained in this form, and who is authorized to verify employment at a school or municipality. Depending on your employer this may be the superintendent, a human resource official, principal, or other municipal official.
- Elementary School: a public or non-private school that provides elementary education as determined by state law.
- Holder: an entity that holds your loan promissory note and has a right to collect from you.
- Loan Servicer: an entity that collects payments on eligible educational loans, responds to customer service inquiries, and performs other administrative tasks associated with maintaining student loans on behalf of a loan holder.
- Municipality: a city, village, or incorporated town in the State of Illinois, but does not include a township, county, school district, park district, sanitary district, or any other similar governmental district.
- Resident of Illinois: a person who physically resides in Illinois and Illinois is his or her true, fixed, and permanent home.
- Secondary School: a public or non-private school that provides secondary education as determined by state law.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- **You must be a United States citizen or eligible noncitizen.**
- You must be a resident of Illinois.
- You must have an outstanding balance due on an eligible educational loan.
- You must not be in default on any federal educational loan, nor owe a refund on any scholarship or grant program administered by the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC).
- You must meet the following requirements: An individual who, <u>on the date of application submission</u>, is currently employed and was employed as a school or municipal social worker for the last 12 consecutive months in the State of Illinois by an:
  - a. Illinois public elementary school;
  - b. Illinois public secondary school; or
  - c. Illinois municipality where the Social Worker does not report directly to a Police Department.
